- Preference will be given to a student majoring in Business or Economics.
- Award will be at the annual AHS Scholarship Award ceremony.
- Award will be sent to the Eastern Washington University Financial Office by the Aberdeen Rotary Foundation upon receipt of verification of the student's full-time enrollment at EWU.
